The Hall is a fine example of an English Manor House and is set in eight acres of landscaped grounds, some overlooking Letchworth Golf Course. The hotel still retains many of its original features including a Minstrels Gallery, Jacobean fireplace and mellow oak panelling.

With many of our rooms licensed for civil ceremonies, we can accommodate a wedding party from 10 guests for a small and intimate ceremony to 280 guests, giving you the flexibility with your guest list. We have 87 bedrooms and two function rooms holding between 50 to 180 people for the Wedding Breakfast and more guests for the evening function.

The Alington Suite

The largest of our suites, the Alington is a selfcontained venue with its own entrance, lobby and bar.

Fully air conditioned and furnished to a very high standard this is the ideal room for Wedding Breakfasts of up to 180 guests with the capacity for up to 250 evening guests



The Marston Suite

An elegant and versatile banqueting room with its own bar and patio area overlooking the lawn, providing a perfect backdrop for your wedding photos.

Wedding receptions for up to 90 guests and can increase to up to 160 for your evening reception.



The Ceremony Rooms

The Great Hall

Licensed for up to 80 guests, the Great Hall is the most popular choice to hold wedding ceremonies in the hotel. It still retains many of the original features from when it was first built in 1625, such as the original Jacobean fireplace and minstrels gallery.

The Summer House

The Butterfield

The Butterfield Suite is the smallest of our licensed rooms for ceremonies. Seating up to 40 guests, the Butterfield is an ideal room for a beautifully intimate cermony.

The Alington Suite

Helpful Wedding Information

Civil Ceremonies

If you are considering a civil marriage you need to select your ceremony venue before confirming a date with the registrar. Due to the increasing popularity of civil marriages we recommend provisionally holding both the venue and the registrar for the date of your choice before confirming either with a deposit.

Letchworth Hall Hotel is an approved venue for civil weddings and partnership ceremonies and is covered by the Stevenage and Hitchin Registry Office. To contact them call 01462 316579

The Dress

This is probably the most important clothing purchase of your life so it is crucial you get it right. Your gown should be a reflection of who you are - your personality and your style.

Cakes

Traditionally wedding cakes were 3 tier fruit cakes - nowadays the wedding cake can be any shape, colour, flavour and size, sometimes with each tier being of a different flavour.

You should order your cake well in advance, at least 6 months before your wedding.

Cars

Consider the distance you have to travel when choosing your transport to the ceremony. Is a horse and carriage or an open top vintage car the best choice of transport for a long (possbly wet) journey?

Flowers

When you talk to your florist, be guided by the following elements - style of your dress, the theme of your wedding and the setting of your ceremony/reception

The Groom's buttonhole should be one of the flowers in his Bride's bouquet. This is a vestige of the time when a knight would wear his Lady's colours to display his love

Photography

One area where we suggest you use a professional and rely on their expertise is with the photography of your wedding. Don't air on the side of politeness or economy when friends or relations offer to take your wedding photographs. You need a professional wedding photographer who can cope with the unforeseen and avoid potential disasters

Invitations and Guest Lists

Choose your wedding invitations carefully as they are the first contact you will have with your guests and can reflect the style you have planned for your special day.

You will need one for each family but it is advisable to allow a few extra copies for the last minute additions

Receiving Your Guests Traditional / Formal

Bride's Mother, Groom's Mother, Bride and Groom, Maid of Honour, Bridesmaids

(The Bride's Father, Groom's Father and Ushers are mingling with the guests)

Tradtional / Modified

Bride's Mother, Bride's Father, Groom's Mother, Groom's Father, Bride and Groom, Maid of Honour, Bridesmaids

(Ushers are mingling with the guests)

Semi Formal

Bride's Mother, Bride's Father, Bride and Groom, Groom's Mother, Groom's Father

(All attendants are mingling with the guests)

Top Table & Speeches

The traditional seating arrangement for the top table is (as you look at the table from right to left)

Best Man, Groom's Mother, Bride's Father, Bride, Groom, Bride's Mother, Groom's Father, Chief Bridesmaid

Speeches are best taken after the meal when your guests are full and merry. The tradtional order is Bride's Father (toasts to the Bride and Groom), Groom (toasts to the Bridesmaids), Best Man (invites guests to raise their glasses to the Bride, Groom and absent friends)

Terms and Conditions

- Payment of the event must be completed within the following time frame
- £1000 deposit on signing of contract
- 25% of the contracted amount is to be paid 6 months prior
- 50% of the contracted amount is to be paid 8 week prior
- Full and final payment to be made 4 weeks before the event
- Any monies paid are non refundable and non transferable
- In the event of cancellation of any booking or non arrival by a customer, the customer shall pay a cancellation/ non arrival fee to the hotel
- 3. Cancellation of the event or reduction in numbers for wedding reception only, the following is applicable: Less than 6 months before the event 25% of the anticipated revenue, less than 8 weeks before the event 50% of anticipated revenue, less than 4 weeks before the event 100% of anticipated revenue.
- 4. All cancellations must be made in writing by registered post, otherwise non arrival charges will be levied as follows: Wedding receptions 100% of total business jost.
- 5. Letchworth Hall Hotel reserves the right to cancel any booking forthwith and without liability on its part in the event of any damage or destruction of the facilities by fire or other natural causes, any shortages of labour or food supplies, strikes, walkouts or industrial unrest or any other causes beyond the hotels control and which prevents it from performing its obligations in connection with any booking. In these circumstances, every effort will be made to accommodate the booking in another suitable establishment, without cost to Letchworth Hall Hotel.
- 6. The customer shall notify Letchworth Hall Hotel of final numbers attending in writing no later than 8 weeks prior to your wedding or at your scheduled 8 week appointment with the Wedding Co-Ordinator. If a customer's booking is accepted by Letchworth Hall Hotel, it is on the basis that a minimum number of guests will attend the function, for which the booking is made. Should these numbers fall below those stipulated at the time of the original booking, then Letchworth Hall Hotel reserves the right to charge a higher rate tariff.

- 7. If the customers final confirmation of guests attending is reduced by 10% or more from its orignal number guaranteed, Letchworth Hall Hotel reserves the right to be able to change the booking to a different suite that best fits the numbers involved. For a reduction of over 30%, we reserve the right to cancel the event.
- 9. Firm prices for food and beverage are established where possible, 3 months prior to the date of the function and are subject to change without prior notice. All prices for rooms, food and beverage items are stated in pounds Sterling and are inclusive of VAT at the current rate. All price changes due to Government regulations will be charged to the client.
- Letchworth Hall Hotel cannot accept responibility for the property of customers and their guests
- 11. Menus outlined in our wedding pack are strictly for customers who have the full package at the hotel ie. wedding breakfast and evening buffet cannot be sold separetely unless a tailor made package has been agreed
- 12. The customer shall be responsible for any damages caused to the hotel and its grounds, furnishings, utensils and equipment therein by the wilful act of default of the customer, their agent or guests of the customer and shall pay Letchworth Hall Hotel, on demand, the amount required to make good or remedy any such damage.
- 13. The customer shall not arrange delivery of, or deliver any goods or materials to Letchworth Hall Hotel unless prior arrangement has been made with the hotel when the goods may be accepted but no liability of the same.
- 14. Letchworth Hall Hotel undertakes full responsibility for all health, safety and hygeine matters and as such any decision made by the hotels employees will be final and take precedence over all activities.

- 15. If you are planning on using external suppliers please gain permission from Letchworth Hall Hotel before confirming the booking with each supplier. All suppliers will be required to provide the hotel with their Public Liability insurance document for cover up to £2million, an up to date PAT certificate for any electrical equipment and health and hygiene documents if relevant. Allowing external suppliers onsite is at the Hotel's discretion.
- 16. The customer shall not store or place on the premises or in the grounds of Letchworth Hall Hotel, any infammable, combustible or objectionable substances or liquids
- 17. The hotel cannot allow food or drink, other than that purchased on the premises to be consumed unless by prior arrangement
- 18. Check in time is 14.00 hours or later. Guests arrivin prior to this may leave their luggage to be stored subject to availability. Cancellation policy there will be no cancellation charge if the booking is cancelled before 12.00 noon on the day of arrival. If the booking is cancelled later or in the case of a no show, the first night will be charged.
- 19. Bedroom blocks will be confirmed with the Wedding Co Ordinator at the time of booking. A unique code will be given to allow your guests to call and book bedrooms. If the code is not quoted then unfortunately we will not be able to accept the booking against the block of rooms.
- 20. One menu should be chosen for the entire party. Special dietary requirements can be catered for. The hotel would need to be notified about these no later than 8 weeks prior to your wedding.
- 21. Letchworth Hall Hotel has car parking facilities for over 200 vehicles, which are available, free of charge to the hotels customers on the day of the event. We cannot however guarante any spaces as these are on a first come first serve basis. The hotel will not be held respinsible for any loss of business due to any problems arising from the car parking. Please note that Letchworth Hall Hotel does not accept any responsibility for theft of/from or damage to vehicles left in the car park.
